

Organizational Patterns (RI.5.5)

1. Chronological Order- the story is organized by dates and times (Ex. timeline)
2. Comparison and Contrast- the story looks at similarities and differences of things. (Ex. Venn Diagram)
3. Cause and Effect- there are causes / occurrences, and they have effects on characters (Ex. hard work= success)
4. Sequential Order- the story follows a step by step pattern (Ex. Food Recipe)
5. Problem and Solution- there is a conflict / problem, and a solution is presented
6. Order of Importance- the most important information goes first, followed by less important information.
