Example  $50p + 20p = 70p = £0.70$

1.  $50p + 10p = \square = \square$

2.  $30p + 40p = \square = \square$

3.  $60p + 20p = \square = \square$

4.  $35p + 25p = \square = \square$

5.  $45p + 15p = \square = \square$

Remember to leave out the pence sign if you write the pounds sign.



These are a little bit harder!

6.  $32p + 28p = \square = \square$

8.  $54p + 16p = \square = \square$

9.  $56p + 12p = \square = \square$

10.  $67p + 13p = \square = \square$
