Sally picked up a pumpkin, sighed, and put it down again.

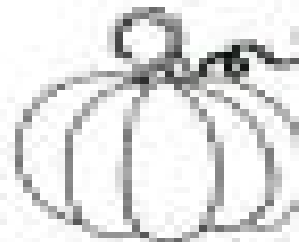
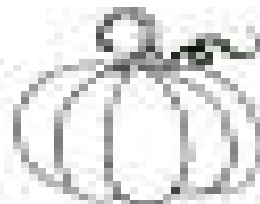
"You need to hurry up," said her mother. "We can't stay here all day."
