What is "debate"? Learning objectives

Argument – two sides don't agree with each other

A **debate** is a competition. Two teams are prepared to support their side and disagree with the other team.

There will get things. They will have opportunities to be **strong** sides.

Each team will have a **topic** (some are "FOR" some are "AGAINST") side.

- FOR means you agree with the topic. You must explain why it is **GOOD**.
- AGAINST means you disagree with the topic. You must find reasons why it is **BAD**.

Remember! It's not about winning or losing.

If you agree the topic, you must **NOT** agree your side is wrong. It's not about the **AGAINST** team, what you **DO** agree, you just don't like that (your side).

Every student will have a chance to speak and debate.

Students will also be **evaluated**, you can see why the other team is wrong.

The teacher will **judge** the competition and decide who the winners are.

Remember! Don't be in the corner yourself.

■ Two teams agree about something.
■ A competition with two teams trying to be the winning team.
