What is "debate"? Learning objectives

Argument – two sides don't agree with each other

A **debate** is a competition. Two teams are prepared to support their side and disagree with the other team.

There will get things. This will have opportunities for to become **spies**.

Each team will have a judge side. There is a "PRO" and another "CONTRARY" side.

- PRO means you agree with the topic. You must explain why it is **BETTER**.
- CONTRARY means you disagree with the topic. You must find reasons why it is **WORSE**.

Remember! It's not about winning or losing.

If you agree the PRO team, even if you, DON'T agree, your job is to argue that you do so for the CONTRARY team, what if you DON'T agree, your job is to say that you don't.

Every student will have a chance to speak and debate.

Students will also be evaluated, you can see why the other team is wrong.

The teacher will judge the competition and decide who the winners are.
