## What is "debate"? Learning objectives

Argument – two sides don't agree with each other

A **debate** is a competition. Two teams are prepared to argue their case and disagree with the other team.

Each team will have a chance to "win" or "lose" the debate. **AGREEMENT** side.

- PCB means you agree with the topic. This means that you are **AGREEMENT**.
- **DISAGREEMENT** means you disagree with the topic. This means that you are **DISAGREEMENT**.

**Remember!** It's not about winning or losing.

If you agree with the topic, you are **AGREEMENT**. If you disagree with the topic, you are **DISAGREEMENT**.

Every student will have a chance to speak and debate.

Students will also be evaluated, you can see why the other team is wrong.

The teacher will judge the competition and decide who the winners are.

Remember! It's not about winning or losing.
