bubble-bun

bubble (n.) 1. a globule of gas in a thin liquid envelope 2. a transparent dome

bugle (n.) 1. a brass wind instrument like a cornet but used typically without valves (v.) 2. to blow a bugle

bulldozer (n.) a large, powerful tractor with a vertical blade at the front and for removing earth, rocks, etc.

bun (n.) 1. a bread roll, either plain or slightly sweetened 2. hair gathered into a round coil

burden-buzzard

burden (n.) 1. a carried load 2. something that burdens (e.g., stress) (v.) 3. to load heavily

burn (v.) to destroy

button (n.) 1. a small disk or knob used as a fastener on clothing 2. an operating device operated by a finger, as a power button (v.) 3. to fasten or be fastened with a button

buzzard (n.) a broad-winged Old World hawk or New World vulture, a common bird
