

A Man With A Dream

Martin Luther King, Jr. (1929-1968), led the way to equality for all Americans. Growing up in Georgia, King suffered the effects of racism and segregation. He vowed that one day he would make our community a better place to live – and he did. With peaceful determination, Dr. King worked to make his dream come true.



"I Have a Dream" is a public speech delivered by American civil rights activist Martin Luther King, Jr. on August 28, 1963, in which he called for an end to racism in the United States.

Determination: **firmness** **determination** **perseverance** **resolution** **will**

Racism: **racial** **race** **racist** **racialism**
the belief that all members of one race have characteristics or abilities specific to that race

Segregation: **segregation** **separatism** **separation**
the action or state of setting someone or something apart from other people or things or being set apart.
