Predicate Nominatives and Predicate Adjectives

A **predicate nominative** is a noun or pronoun that follows a <u>linking verb</u> and renames or identifies the subject.

(Remember – a <u>linking verb</u> is also called a *state-of-being* verb. It is not doing any action.)

Examples:

Nina's **aunt** is a police **officer**. [Officer is a noun that renames the subject *aunt*.]

The **person** in charge of the investigation is **she**. [She is a pronoun that identifies the subject *person*.]

A **predicate adjective** is an adjective that follows a $\underline{\text{linking verb}}$ and modifies, or describes, the subject.

(Remember – a <u>linking verb</u> is also called a *state-of-being* verb. It is not doing any action.)

Examples:

Justin seems **angry** about something. [*Angry* is an adjective that describes the subject *Justin*.]

The quart of milk smells sour. [Sour is an adjective that describes the subject quart.]
