When you want to add "ED" to a word that ends in a consonant followed by a "Y," change the "Y" to an "I" and add "ED" to the end of the word. (play = played)

When we want to add "ED" to a word with one vowel followed by one consonant, we must double the final consonant before adding "ED" (runned/runned)
