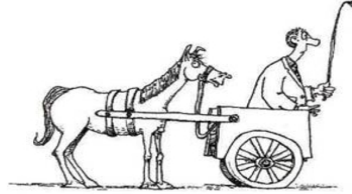


Horse Idioms
