<p>A point is pictured by a dot. It is named with a capital letter. This is point A.</p>	<p>A line segment is a straight path between 2 points. This is line segment BC or CB. It is written \overline{BC} or \overline{CB}.</p>	<p>A line is a straight path that goes on forever in both directions. This is line DE or ED. It is written \overleftrightarrow{DE} or \overleftrightarrow{ED}.</p>	<p>A ray is a straight path that goes on forever in one direction. This is ray FG. It is written \overrightarrow{FG}.</p>

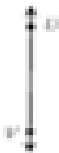
