DEFINITION	ELEMENTS OF POETRY
is a comparison between two unlike things using the words "like" or "as".	
is a common type of rhyme in poetry that occurs when the last word of two or more lines rhyme.	
is a fourteen-line poem with a set rhyme scheme, often divided into quatrains, octaves, and sestets.	
is a formal lyric poem written in celebration or dedication of something with specific intent.	
is a group of lines set off from others by a blank line or indentation.	
is a stanza pattern found in medieval and modern long poetry.	
is a fourteen-line poem with a set rhyme scheme, often divided into quatrains, octaves, and sestets.	
is a personal piece of poetry that tends to be shorter, melodic, and contemplative.
