

27 Amendments to US Constitution

- 1- freedom of speech, press, assembly, petition, and religion
- 2- right to bear arms
- 3- no quartering of soldiers
- 4- no illegal search and seizure/exclusionary rule
- 5- right to remain silent, no double jeopardy, eminent domain, criminal due process
- 6- right to counsel(attorney), fair and speedy trial
- 7- jury trial in civil cases
- 8- no cruel or unusual punishment/no excessive bail
- 9- rights of the people (privacy, right to associate, etc)
- 10-reserved powers- powers to the state governments
- 11-limits lawsuits against us govt
- 12-separate election for president/vp
- 13-abolition of slavery
- 14-due process, equal protection clause, incorporation
- 15-cannot prevent voting based on race, creed, previous condition of servitude
- 16-created income tax
- 17-direct election of senators
- 18-prohibition
- 19-women's suffrage
- 20-lame duck election (date moved from march to January)
- 21-repeal of 18th amendment
- 22-limits president to two terms in office (10 yrs total)
- 23-3 electoral votes given to Washington D.C.
- 24-abolition of poll taxes
- 25-line of succession for president/ presidential disability procedures
- 26- 18 to 21 yr olds given right to vote
- 27-limits congressional pay raises
