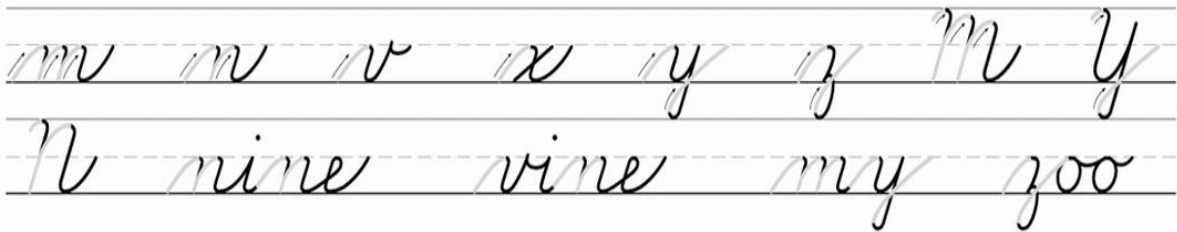


**Overcurve** The overcurve is used to begin the lowercase letters **m**, **n**, **v**, **x**, **y**, and **z**. This stroke curves up and wide to the right. Do not curve up quickly, the stroke should be rounded and wide. Trace and write the tall and short overcurves.



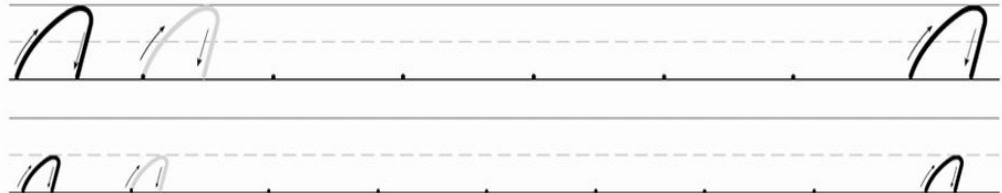
Trace the overcurves in the letters and words below. The overcurve goes up and over to the right.

**Overcurve-Slant** The overcurve-slant motion is used very often in cursive writing. Be sure to make the overcurve well rounded. Trace and write the tall and short overcurve-slant motions. Pull the slant strokes to the baseline.
