I. Meekness Toward Parents (based on Genesis 22)

A. How does Isaac demonstrate this idea?

He was willing to let Abraham kill him. He didn't argue or protest.

B. Review Exodus 20:12. What does it instruct? What is the reward from God for doing this?

Honor your father and mother. The reward is a long life in the land He has given you.

C. Is it hard to demonstrate meekness to your parents in an "all about me" society?

II. Meekness Toward God (Genesis 24:1-27, 50-67 – Isaac & Rebekah)

C. How does Rebekah's family demonstrate this idea?

Abimelech told Isaac to move away and Isaac obeyed without arguing or fighting.

C. Can we demonstrate meekness in this area if our leaders are not God-honoring? How?

Follow the laws of God and don't follow the non God-honoring laws of officials.

IV. Meekness Toward Other People (Genesis 26:19-22 – Isaac Responds to Others)

A. How does Isaac demonstrate this idea?

He avoids conflict twice by moving and building new wells until the arguments stopped.

they may be wrong.
