

Kitchen Cleanability (Answers)

Open pan: Don't leave food to burn on.

Wipe Wipe about the stove to catch drips.

Wipe front edge: Wipe the front edge of combination cooktops and ovens.

Use lubricated cooking spray: Use separate cooking spray for nonstick cookware and pans.

Exhausting/Blowing: Use exhaust fan or blow away immediately.

Wipe the stove: Use paper towels for regular clean-up and avoid scrubbing after use.

Approved cleaners: Use foods stored in glass, ceramic, enameled or metal containers that allow drying.

Oil: Keep your oil filter separate and clean.

Design: If you water immediately, the stove shouldn't need special cleaning after that.

Good hygiene is essential: Clean up spills, food splatters, and crumbs as you finish each item.

Wipe spills: Clean up spills and stains immediately after using.

Wipe the front of the stove.
