Value: the lightness to darkness of a hue.

Monochromatic Colors are all the colors (hue) and shades of a single hue.

• Tint is a hue (a color) + white added

• Shade is a hue (a color) + black added

White	White + Yellow + Yellow	White + Yellow equal proportions	White + Yellow + white	Yellow
White	White + Orange + Blue	White + Orange equal proportions	White + Blue + white	Blue

• Shade is a hue (a color) + Black added

• Tint is a hue (a color) + white added

White	White + White + Black	White + Black equal proportions	Black + Black + white	Black
Black	Black + Red + Black	Black + Red equal proportions	Black + Black + Red	Red
Black	Black + Blue + Black	Black + Blue equal proportions	Black + Black + Blue	Blue
