Adjectives that are used to compare two people or two things have special forms.
* If the regular adjective has one syllable, add *-er*.
(Make the second consonant double if the first syllable ends in a vowel.)

If the regular adjective has two syllables and ends in *-y*, change the *y* to *i* before adding *-er*.
If the regular adjective has two or more syllables, use the word *more* before the adjective and do not add *-er*.
