Sphere



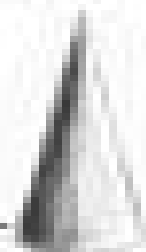
A sphere is a three-dimensional object that is perfectly round. It has no edges or corners. The surface of a sphere is smooth and curved. It is a common shape in nature and art.

Cone

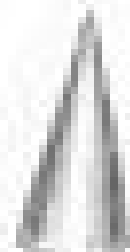


A cone is a three-dimensional object that has a circular base and a pointed top. The surface of a cone is smooth and curved. It is a common shape in nature and art.

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Cylinder



A cylinder is a three-dimensional object that has two parallel circular bases connected by a curved surface. It is a common shape in nature and art.

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
