

Letters are capitalized when they start sentences and begin words that name a special person, place, or thing.

Identifying words that need capitalization

Something's wrong! Circle all the letters that need to be capitalized.

Example:

1. (c)j and @edison are good friends.
2. dr. listick wants all the jewels for himself.
3. stanley works for dr. listick.
4. c.j and edison keep getting locked out.
5. the friends may go to the park on Sunday.
6. bingo has many dingo pals.
7. on Tuesday, edison is going to c.j's house.
8. did you know that edison is a firefly?
