

Characteristics of Effective Adult Models

Characteristic	Definition	Examples from Adult Classes	Examples from Adult Groups
Prognostic	Ability to assess cause of the client's learning problem, and to further attempt to reduce barriers identified as potential within ongoing class.		
Integrated	Characteristics encompass the core adult group within the group.		
Dynamic or Developing Character	A character who changes and evolves during the course of a week of classes.		
Stable Character	A character who does not change or develop during the course of a week of classes.		
Flat Character	A character who does not reveal enough who to quickly within each week following class.		
Fixed Character	A character who does not grow through the course of the week following class.		
Knowledge	A character that reports or demonstrates their understanding during class, group, etc.
