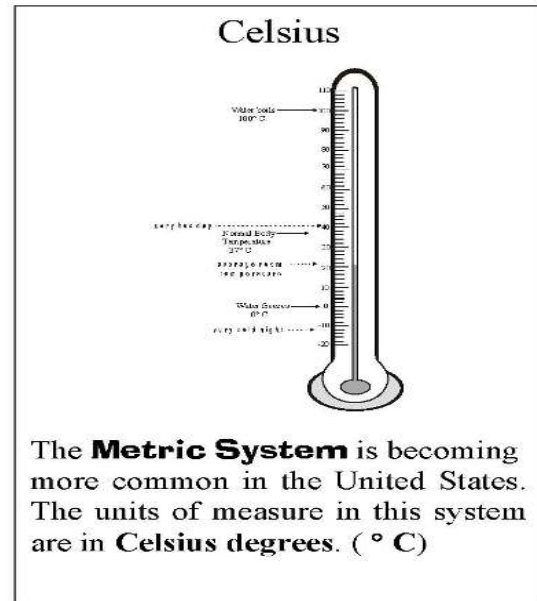
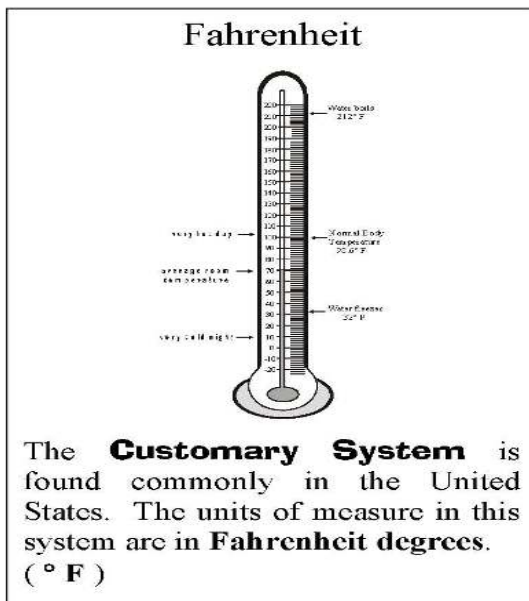


Temperature

Temperature is the measure of how hot or cold an object is in relation to a standard value (*degrees*). There are two common systems of measurement:



- In both systems a rise in temperature means that the **weather (or object) is becoming warmer**. (e.g.: A rise in temperature from $5^{\circ}F$ to $10^{\circ}F$ means that the weather has become warmer by 5 degrees.)
- The temperature dropping means that the **object or weather is becoming colder**. (e.g.: A fall in temperature from $10^{\circ}F$ to $5^{\circ}F$ means that the weather has become cooler by 5 degrees.)
