Transitive and Intransitive verbs

Decide in the active voice (acc. and nom. singular) to complete the sentence, if it is intransitive. Write in the infinitive the intransitive object, if intransitive verbs are transitive. Think of transitive verbs as "transferring" or "transmitting" their action to a direct object.
