


## Volume

is the amount of cubic units it takes to fill an object. There are two common systems of measurement:

The **Customary System** is found commonly in the United States. The units of measure in this system are: teaspoons, tablespoons, ounces, cups, pints, quarts, and gallons.



The **Metric System** is becoming more common in the United States. The units of measure in this system are: milliliters and liters.



A dropper holds about a milliliter of liquid. A quart is approximately a liter of liquid.

1000 milliliters = 1 liter
