Identifying compound words

Match a word from Mountain A to a word from Mountain B to form a new compound word. Use each word only once.

Example

Mountain A

Mountain B

store	cup	brow	yard
light	day	walk	board
ball	room	fire	dreams
stairs	way	part	father
lace	print	brush	fighter



Challenge your child to search around the home for examples of compound words. Have him make a list of his findings. Encourage your child to include parts of the home (such as bedroom or doorway), pieces of furniture (such as bookshelf or stepstool), foods in the cupboard (such as peanuts or cupcakes), and miscellaneous items (such as flashlight or dustpan). Your child will be delighted with all the compounds he finds!
