A ham and salad sandwich costs \$3.50 and a bottle
of juice cost \$1.20.
If he buys this everyday for one week, how much
will he spend?

- If Trent puts \$3.00 in his piggy bank each week.
How much will he have in 12 weeks?
How much will he have in 1 year?
How much will he have in 3 years?



- If a radio station plays a song every 15 minutes how many songs
does it play in a day?
If the radio station decides to play 15 songs per hour (from 5:00 p.m.
to 7:00 p.m.).
How many songs will they now play in a day?

Dave, Peter and Sarah were all finalists in a two-handled sword
swinging competition.

Dave ate 20 carrots,
Peter ate 12 and a half carrots
and Sarah ate 18 and a half carrots..

How many carrots were eaten all together?

It took Dave 1 hour to finish 20 carrots.
How many minutes did it take for him to finish 1 carrot?
