

Inverse Relationships Mult/Div (A)

Instructions: Use the information given to fill in each box.

since $4 \times 6 = 24$
then $24 \div 4 = \boxed{}$

since $4 \times 6 = 24$
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since $1 \times 6 = 6$
then $6 \div 1 = \boxed{}$

since $8 \times 5 = 40$
then $40 \div 8 = \boxed{}$

since $3 \times 4 = 12$

since $1 \times 4 = 4$
then $4 \div 1 = \boxed{}$

since $7 \times 5 = 35$
