Question Answer Relationship

This is a strategy that will help you answer questions about things you read.

It will help you to recognize when the answer is in the text and when you will need to use your own mind and knowledge.

There are 4 types of questions that you can encounter in all your assignments.

I am going to explain the types of questions to you and then show you some examples.

1st Right There questions

The answer will be found in one place in the text

2nd Think and Search questions

The answer will be scattered throughout the text. You will have to search through it and think to bring your answer together.

3rd Author and Me questions

The answer will combine information that the Author has given you and your own ideas or knowledge.

4th On Your Own questions

The answer will come from your own ideas and knowledge on the topic.
