

## Singular-Plural

How to change the *Singular* to *Plural* in English:

Note: Vowels: a, e, i, o, u

Consonants: all the other letters

- Add S: flowers, pen-pens, cat-cats, heart-hearts, mobile-mobiles, jacket-jackets, .....
- Add ES to words ending in (s, ch, sh, x, z): bus-buses, match-matches, brush-brushes, box-boxes, buzz-buzzes, .....
- Change f to V and then add ES: leaf-leaves, knife-knives, wife-wives, shelf-shelves, .....
- When words end in y with a consonant before it, drop the y and add ies: lady-ladies, baby-babies, trophy-trophies, .....

Exceptions: woman-women, man-men, roof-roofs, cliff-cliffs, roof-roofs, mouse-mice, goose-geese, foot-feet, tooth-teeth, child-children.
