Underline the GREATEST common factor (GCF) in the numerator and denominator

$$\frac{4}{12}$$

$$\begin{array}{c} 4 \\ \wedge \\ 2 \times 2 \end{array}$$

$$\begin{array}{c} 4 \\ \wedge \\ \underline{4} \times 1 \end{array}$$

$$\begin{array}{c} 12 \\ \wedge \\ 3 \times \underline{4} \end{array}$$

$$\begin{array}{c} 12 \\ \wedge \\ 6 \times 2 \end{array}$$

$$\begin{array}{c} 12 \\ \wedge \\ 12 \times 1 \end{array}$$
