### Basic structure of an argumentative essay

1. **Introduction page**
  - a. Attentional hook
  - b. Background about today's relevance
  - c. A question
2. **Main body** - 4-5 paragraphs to discuss the issue
  - a. each paragraph start with argument by introducing evidence (statistics)
  - b. topic of the good writing (the topic is controversial)
  - c. start with the keyword (keyword of good with the strongest case)
3. **Conclusion**
  - a. A summary of your arguments
  - b. an outlook for the future

- c. **Opposition** - only the second
- d. **Support** - supports the conclusion

**Tip:** Give your writing a strong conclusion to finish with!

1. **Introduction**
