Read the following text about Child labour in Victorian times.

During the 1800s the Industrial Revolution spread in Britain. There were more and more factories. Factories wanted children because they were small and cheap and they could go under the machines. They started to work at the age of seven. One day the workers were children between seven and thirteen. Some children had to work in the coal mines. They died at the age of 25 on average.

The owners of cotton mills took orphans. Orphans did not have anything, so in exchange for their work they received food and a place to sleep. Some children fell sick while working and fell into the machines.

There is an act in 1833 : children aged 9 to 13 were not allowed to work for more than 9 hours a day or a total of more than 48 hours a week. In 1880 the law said that children aged 5 to 10 had to go to primary school.
