

## Peer Pressure – Group Activity

As a group, choose one of the four topics above. In each group you will have the following characters –

- one person who is the source of the Peer Pressure
- one person (or two people in a group of four) who are being pressured
- one person who is being victimized

### Assignment

As a group, prepare a story about Peer Pressure for your topic. Next class, you present your story to the class.

- Your presentation should be 3 – 5 minutes
- All of your group members must be involved
- Your presentation should be an example of Peer Pressure
- Your presentation should provide the class with a good method for dealing with Peer Pressure
- There should be **no swearing or violence** in your presentation

Make sure that your presentation has a good and positive ending. You can use pages 141-144 of your textbook for strategies for dealing with Peer Pressure.
