7. You want to buy one to the (consumption) budget (with popcorn and 1 hot dog) and 1 hot dog and 1 hot dog. If you pay \$20.00, how much change will you get back?
8. You buy 1 pop, 1 candy, 1 cookie, and 1 hot dog for your friend and yourself. If you pay \$20.00, how much change will you get back?
