

## Ordinal Numbers

We use ORDINAL NUMBERS to tell the positions of people or things that are in order.

1 <sup>st</sup> - first	7 <sup>th</sup> - seventh	13 <sup>th</sup> - thirteenth	19 <sup>th</sup> - nineteenth
2 <sup>nd</sup> - second	8 <sup>th</sup> - eighth	14 <sup>th</sup> - fourteenth	20 <sup>th</sup> - twentieth
3 <sup>rd</sup> - third	9 <sup>th</sup> - ninth	15 <sup>th</sup> - fifteenth	21 <sup>st</sup> - twenty-first
4 <sup>th</sup> - fourth	10 <sup>th</sup> - tenth	16 <sup>th</sup> - sixteenth	22 <sup>nd</sup> - twenty-second
5 <sup>th</sup> - fifth	11 <sup>th</sup> - eleventh	17 <sup>th</sup> - seventeenth	23 <sup>rd</sup> - twenty-third
6 <sup>th</sup> - sixth	12 <sup>th</sup> - twelfth	18 <sup>th</sup> - eighteenth	24 <sup>th</sup> - twenty-fourth



The horse is first in line.  
The sheep is second in line.  
The puppy is third in line.  
The calf is fourth in line.  
The pig is fifth in line.  
The farmer is sixth in line.  
The duck is seventh in line.
