- ④ **Conclusions:** The first two steps in developing a new product are to identify the market and to identify the product idea. Then, the third step is to evaluate the product idea. This leads to the final step.

⑤ From the previous discussion, we can observe that there are three product idea evaluation methods: the "top-down" method, the "bottom-up" method, and the "middle-out" method. The "top-down" method starts with a general idea and then narrows it down to specific products. The "bottom-up" method starts with specific products and then broadens them to general ideas. The "middle-out" method starts with a general idea and then narrows it down to specific products. These three methods are complementary and can be used together to evaluate product ideas.
