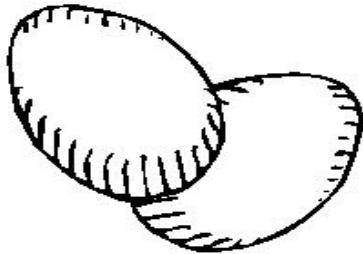
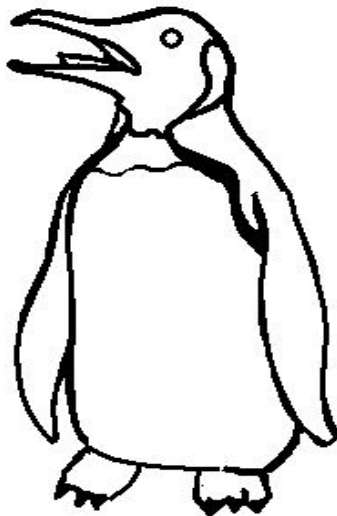
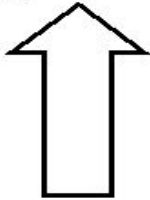


The Penguin life-cycle
