

Story Elements

Genre	The type of story or literary work
Author	Person who writes the story/book
Setting	Where and when a story takes place
Main Characters	The important people in the story
Themes	<p>The underlying or stated main idea of a story</p> <p>*Often, the author implies the theme through the narrator's/bath character's thoughts and feelings. The theme can also be the message an author is trying to send.</p>
Conflict	<p>The major problem in the story</p> <p>Two categories of conflict:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. External—happens outside of the character, involves more than 1 person, can be observed 2. Internal—happens inside of the character, involves only 1 person, can only be observed in the thoughts & feelings <p>Three types of conflict:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Man vs. Nature (External) 2. Man vs. Self (Internal) 3. Man vs. Man (External or Internal)
Climax	One large event that changes the outcome of the entire story
Plot	<p>The sequence of all events in a story</p> <p>*The plot is usually what we summarize</p>
Critique	A reader's personal thoughts & opinions on the story or book: *Involves both "Likes" and "Dislikes"
