WORD	DEFINITION(s)
participating	To take part in; be a part of  Ex: I enjoy <u>participating</u> in the softball games on the playground.
permission	Telling someone they are allowed to do something  Ex: You have to have your parents' permission  before going on the field trip.
personal	Has to do with a particular person  Ex: The books in the classroom are my <u>personal</u> copies.
petroleum	An oily, thick, flammable liquid many times found by drilling  Ex: When drillers have a hard time finding petroleum, our gas prices go up.
pier	A structure built on posts that reach from land over the water.  Ex: I like to do my fishing from the <u>pier</u> .
poked	To push with a finger or an object; To extend or reach out  Ex: The boy sitting beside me continuously <b>poked</b> my arm with his pencil.  She <b>poked</b> her head around the corner.
politician	A person who holds a public office  Ex: The <u>politician</u> created many commercials before the elections to try to gain votes from the people.
porch	An outside addition to a house  Ex: I like to sit on the front porch in the summer and watch the people walk by.
precious	Having a high price or valuable; meaning a lot to someone  Ex: We saw the <u>precious</u> gems at the museum.
preparation	To get ready  Ex: There is a lot of <u>preparation</u> for setting up a science lab.
