

Healthy American Monthly Budget Worksheet

These are standard budget categories.

In each category, enter dollar amounts for those items relevant to you (if they are not relevant to you, leave them blank). Total the amount in each gray box for that category. Add all the gray boxes together to get your monthly spending. If you live in a residence hall, ask whoever pays your charges how much it costs for room and board for a semester and divide it by 4 months for your housing and utilities. Enter the other costs as they apply.
