

Ideas for Catholic Schools Week

General Ideas

- Consider using a daily theme and have activities that correspond to Faith, Hope, Love (our Fundamental Different Scripture verses, liturgy)
- Appreciation Days (Students, Parish, Teacher/Principal, Students, Teacher/Staff/Parents) (assign classes to make catholic-themed bouquets for the different groups or individuals to thank them)
- Create an atmosphere that is balanced between faith learning and fun
- Consider doing an activity that spreads the word about your school to the community (Parade, banners, Commercial or Presentation Signs)
- Mass/Novena
- Guest speakers
- Students self-reflection

School-Wide Ideas

- Daily Mass or Prayer Service
- Day of Service - consider the needs of your parish, school, or local community
- Day of Retreat (meeting needs of different age groups)
- Honoring different classes - each class would "adopt" another class and do something(s) to honor them, such as spiritual bouquets, cards, crafts, treats, letters
- Inter-class activities - mix and mingle groups of different grades for fun and spiritual activities
- Faith filled movie theater (your gymnasium)
