honest - adjective who is very bold.

harmless - someone who is usually not bad for things.

harmless - someone who is friendly and kind. (the opposite of mean)

hastier - used to describe someone who doesn't talk very much.

hastier - bad-tempered. impolite

hastier - used to describe someone who only thinks about themselves.

hastier - someone who is always angry, very temperable (the opposite of calm).
