\_\_\_\_\_ a term used to describe the act of cleaning a horse.

\_\_\_\_\_ a mature horse of either gender that will never grow taller than 14.2 hands (58")

\_\_\_\_\_ also called a horseshoer, this is a skilled craftsman who trims and shoes horses.

\_\_\_\_\_ a piece of equipment used on an English saddle which helps hold the saddle on the horse.

\_\_\_\_\_ a male horse that has been castrated

\_\_\_\_\_ a term that loosely refers to all equipment used on a horse (halter, saddle, bareback pads, etc.)

\_\_\_\_\_ the unit of measurement by which a horse's height is determined. A hand is equal to 4 inches.

\_\_\_\_\_ the slight ridge in the horse's backbone, just behind the mane. A horse's height is measured from the tallest point of its withers.

\_\_\_\_\_ a mature female horse over 4 years old
