## Pronouns

Pronouns take the place of a noun in a sentence.

Example: **Gabe** likes to draw. **He** does not like to write.

The pronoun *he* takes place of the noun Gabe

Common pronouns used in the subject of a sentence include: *he, she, you, we, they, and I.*

Common pronouns used in the predicate of a sentence include: *him, her, you, us, them, and me.*
