3/4	Some errors in information	Some errors in showing how each section of the republic connects to each other.	Diagram is not yet clear and functional.
2/3	Many errors in information or missing parts. Diagram is unclear and does not show how each of the different branches connected to each other.	Some concepts understood but not a clear idea of how the Republic worked.	Diagram is unclear or it is more a picture.
