

Direct and Indirect Object Pronouns

A **direct object** is a noun or pronoun that receives the action of a verb in a sentence.

Example: I kicked the ball. (The ball received the kicking.) What is what is received by the action?

Subject Pronouns- Used at the beginning of a sentence	Object pronouns- Used as an object, usually at the end of the sentence
I	Me
You	You
He	him
She	her
It	it
We	us
They	Them

An **indirect object** is the noun or pronoun that receives the direct object.

Example: She gave a gift to me. (The gift is the direct object but she gave it to me.) To whom is to what is the direct object affecting.

NOTE: The indirect object always comes before the direct object.

Example: She gave me a gift. (She is the indirect object because I am receiving the gift.)
