

Shoe Tying & Lacing Practice

Start a piece of paper with cutting and glue!

1. Print this page out and cut off the shoes. 2. Use the white space with the shoes to make shoe cutouts (like a real shoe!). 3. After the glue is dry you can use the shoes. 4. Then, cut off the extra paper. 5. Fold around each shoe and use a single hole punch to punch holes where the shoelaces will go. 6. Now you can practice tying or lacing your shoes! Tape the shoes to a table to keep them still when you tie.

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
