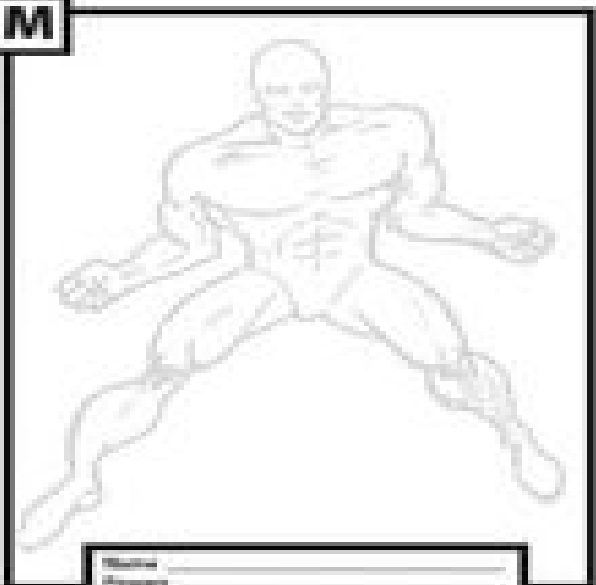
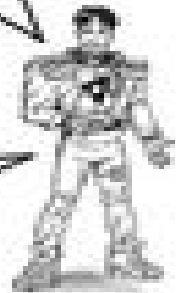


WORK SHEET #1 HERO DESIGN

Tips:

- If you want to give things an edge, use the lines with a black pen or marker (not a ballpoint pen).
- The pose lines of the figures are just guides for you to use the basic form of the figure. Only use a line that you want to make a permanent feature of your hero's look.
- Draw all sketches about a page machine, but also do not want to use your regular paper. Draw a sheet of blank graph paper in front of every page. Use the "top-down" principle. You should be able to see the bottom "frame" through the paper well enough to design your hero.
- If you make copies of your design, use the top position of a lighter setting so that the gray figure guidelines fade out.
