1	A1	1/1/29-11/13/29	Written when Pullias first fell in love with Pauline, tells of that budding love, experiences in teaching at Hardy Memorial School in Richard City, TN, and summer at his home place with his parents and brothers	Book A1/Box 1/Series 11
2	A2	1/11-8/21/30	Written when Pullias was 23 & deeply in love with Pauline. They are both teaching at Hardy Memorial School in Richard City, TN. Volume presents his philosophy, thoughts stimulated by his experiences, things he reads, and people with whom he is associated	Book A2/Box 1/Series 11
3	B	12/31/30-10/11/31	Occasional Thoughts by Earl & Pauline Pullias, September, 1930; account actually begins 12/31/30. Dr. Pullias and Pauline were married at this time. It is his first year at the University of Chicago. In the fall he begins work at Duke Univ.	Book B/Box 1/Series 11
4	C	10/23/31-12/11/33	Dr Pullias, now at Duke Univ. evaluates the university, records his reaction to his teachers and a number of his fellow students. He also discusses books he is reading and his church experiences at the Christian Church.	Book C/Box 1/Series 11
5	D	1/1/34-12/31/34	In this volume Dr. Pullias begins a more detailed analysis of his daily experience, at times analyzes his emotional reactions and his personal growth. On May 26 he discusses his Greek grandfather.	Book D/Box 1/Series 11
6	E	1/1/35-12/31/35	Erroneously dates 1st entry 1/1/34. Gives his purpose for keeping the journal and analyzes self. Reaction to Calvin's birth and growth as an infant. Completed dissertation. Review of 9 books. Several quotations. An essay and poem "Teach Me Oh Sage"	Book E/Box 1/Series 11
7	F	1/1/36-12/31/36	Year Pullias completed doctorate at Duke. Includes several letters/telegrams he received/brief summary of 18 books he had read, and several "valuable quotations."	Book F/Box 1/Series 11
8	G	1/1/37-3/6/38	Includes acceptance of position to head Psyc Dept at new Pepperdine College, his study trip to England in 37-38, several letters he received, a letter to his father asking to borrow \$200, review of 16 books, a Psyc exam on which Pauline rated in top 1%.	BookG/Box 2/Series 11
9	H	11/1/33-7/5/37	Pauline's Journal. Sometimes she responds to the same event Dr. Pullias had recorded in his journals. Records books she has read, reviews of several. Last portion records Calvin's progress as a child.	Book H/Box 2/Series 11

11	I2	1967-71	Pauline's 5-yr journal of her daily activities; frequently refers to Dr. Pullias' professional work and her work on reading dissertations of students in the Higher Education program and their trips and times of retreat to their Hemet cabin	Book I2/Box 2/Series 11
12	I3	1972-76	Pauline's 5-yr journal of her daily activities. Frequently refers to Dr. Pullias' professional work, her work in reading students' dissertations and their trips, associations with friends, and retreats to their Hemet cabin	Book I3/Box 2/Series 11
